### Nominations and Applications

Nominations for both STAPH and ZSA are due no later than **November 14, 2016**. Nomination instructions may have already been sent to your schools. For schools not on our mailing list, we are happy to provide materials. Simply contact us at the phone number or e-mail above and indicate the appropriate contact person at your school.

Student applications are due **January 30, 2017**. While student applications can be processed after that date, admission is competitive and students are strongly encouraged to complete the process on time for the best opportunity to secure a spot.

### Fees

Tuition for either STAPH or ZSA costs \$900. This fee includes all room and board and the expenses for all required activities. Students needing transportation from the Kirksville or Kansas City airports may incur additional charges. Recommended or required supplies and/or textbooks are described in detail on the programs' respective websites and can be procured at very affordable rates.

### Scholarship Assistance

Scholarship assistance is available for both programs and may be requested at the time of application. Scholarships are limited and are applied based on a combination of academic ability and financial need, with financial need being the dominant consideration. For the STAPH program, students from rural areas with an interest in future careers in rural health care may receive additional consideration for aid. Children of active duty members of the United States military are eligible for an automatic tuition reduction of \$100 prior to the assignment of any financial aid award.
